

You will receive your e-signed acceptance letter once your admission has been evaluated and you may proceed with the tuition fee payment. After your payment, your confirmation letter will be issued.

You will receive your confirmation letter once your payment has been completed. You will be able to download it through the online application portal. Then, you may proceed with the visa application (if needed) procedures. Our university shares information with airport and sea entry points; of only those applicants whose admission and confirmation is fully complete.

Step 3

Go to your student portal and check financial section and tuition fee status. You can pay online by debit/credit card or via bank transfer (bank receipt should be uploaded), and payments can be made in full or in installments.

*For entry procedures, applicants must carry originals of their related documents which were used for their admission.

You may complete your registration on your arrival to North Cyprus.



Applying to Eastern Mediterranean University is free. University fees consist of tuition and student fund fees.. When your application to EMU has been approved, your first tuition fee will be stated on your acceptance letter. Once you make the payment, you will be issued a student certificate that will allow you to proceed with travelling and registration procedures. In addition to tuition fees, you will consider other expenses such as books, supplies, residency permit, health insurance, accommodation, transportation, food, entertainment and other.






