North Cyprus cuisine is quite varied, with many dishes featuring meat and vegetables to encompass the healthy Mediterranean diet. The local cuisine is an extension of the locals' hospitality.

LIVING EXPENSES

The cost of living in North Cyprus will depend on your standard of living, but in general it is around US 300 - US 500 per month (excluding tuition fees, textbooks and accommodation).

CAMPUS CARD

• A Campus card is automatically prepared for each student who completes his/her registration.

• Campus cards shall be ready within a period of 14 days to a month following the registration of the students and should be personally collected from the Campus card desk located in the Registrar's Office.

• Students with a broken or missing Campus card should apply to the Student Services Office for the broken/missing card procedures.

• The ready Campus cards shall be collected by the students within the specified dates from the Registrar's Office.

• Students must bring their campus cards to all exams.

• The card is a debit card and can be used for payment in any shop. Additionally, the

card may be credited with units which can be debited for payments.

APOSTILLE APPROVAL PROCEDURES

Apostille procedures are required for graduate students who are to study/work in Europe or the United States. Apostille approval is done on behalf of students by the Student Services Office at the Registrar's Office.

EMBASSY PROCEDURES FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

All international students graduating from EMU are expected to have their diplomas approved by their country's embassies in Ankara.

STUDENT SERVICES FUND

An amount of \$200 is collected from all students at each registration. This contributes to the organization of campus events and other services for students.

IMMIGRATION PROCEDURES

• Those who will study at an undergraduate, graduate, master's or doctorate program at a higher education institution in the Turkish Republic of Northern Cyprus are required to apply for a student residence permit.

• In order to start the immigration procedures, you must have an active student status.

• Update your personal information from your departmental desk at the Registrar's Office.

• Once the information has been updated, the data will be transferred to the online system of the TRNC Ministry of Internal Affairs within the same day.

• Then, start your registration procedures at the online immigration procedures section of the webpage of the TRNC Ministry of Internal Affairs. (https://permissions.gov.ct.tr)

• After accessing the TRNC Ministry of Internal Affairs' webpage, you need to click on "register now", fill in the requested information on the page that opens and complete the registration process.

 After the requested information has been completed, information regarding your user code and password will be sent to you via e-mail or telephone. In line with this information, you will be able to access the immigration page.

 After logging into the Immigration page, you must first approve your health report. If you have a health report, upload it to the system in PDF format.

 Health reports for students with Turkish nationality must be obtained from a fully-fledged state or university hospital (the validity period is 2 years.)

• Medical reports should include lung scopy or chest X-ray for tuberclosis and HCV-HIV-HBSAG-RPR examinations. (Reports are valid for 2 months from the date of receipt.) • Students from 3rd countries will obtain their medical reports at the health institutions specified by the immigration system (valid for 1 year).

• After uploading the health reports to the system, the reports must be submitted to the relevant State Hospital.

• State hospital health reports unit will evaluate the uploaded health report and ensure the continuation of the process. The result of the laboratory examination will be approved over the single physician report fee specified in the Health Institutions Fee Schedule Regulation of the TRNC Ministry of Health. However, in cases where the Ministry requires additional examinations, students will pay the full fee according to the fee schedule set in the Health Institutions Fees Tariff Regulation.


• Students who do not have a health report will follow the procedures at the Student Permits Automation System in order to receive a health report.

 You will proceed to the next stage after the reports uploaded to the system are approved by the Ministry of Health.

• Information about the student permits that are ready will be sent to the phone number or e-mail address you specified during registration.

• Students who have completed their immigration procedures can obtain their residence permit from their own immigration procedures portal. Further information can be obtained from the immigration procedures guideline.

(https://permissions.gov.ct.tr/documents/help_ tr.pdf) In order to complete Immigration Procedures, it is mandatory to enter TRNC with a passport. Immigration procedures are completed online. Follow the steps listed below to complete the process:



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Students who complete the registration procedures are required to complete the immigration procedures within the period of time provided upon their entry to TRNC.

Students who fail to complete the immigration procedures within the specified period of time will be subject to a daily penalty due to not holding a legal residence permit.

Students coming from third countries are obliged to renew their health reports every year. Students coming from Turkey are obliged to renew their health reports every 2 years.

REGISTRATION

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Conditions for Admission and Registration.

The applicant must submit a certified copy of Higher Secondary School Certificate or Intermediate Certificate or the equivalent, demonstrating that s/he has satisfactorily graduated from a secondary school, and must arrange for other relevant certified documents, such as transcripts or detailed mark sheets, to be released to EMU.

APPLICATION TO UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS

Applications to the undergraduate programs are accepted twice a year.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS TO GRADUATE PROGRAMS

Applications to the graduate programs at EMU can be made throughout the year, until one month prior to the beginning of each semester.
Applicants are advised to make their applications by the end of December or August for Spring and Fall semesters, respectively. Application deadlines are announced on the web site of the Institute for Graduate Studies and Reasearch and the Registrar's Office. Prospective applicants are required to apply online.

ACADEMIC ADVISING

CLASS ATTENDANCE

Students are responsible for attending the lessons, laboratory hours and workshops, all the exams that take place within the semester and all other projects/applications to fulfil program requirements. A student who fails to attend 20% or more of a course or its applications without any excuse, fails the course and receives a Nil Grade (NG). The student is accepted as unsuccessful due to not attending the course.

GRADE CALCULATION (CGPA - GPA)

A student's academic achievement for each term is expressed numerically by an index referred to as the 'Grade Point Average' - GPA. The GPA is the weighted average of course grades. When calculating the course grade, mid-term exam(s), the final exam, lab/workshop reports and/or exams (if applicable), tests, projects, and/or homework are taken into consideration. FOREIGN LANGUAGES AND ENGLISH PREPARATORY SCHOOL

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

Students who are enrolled in English-medium programs at Eastern Mediterranean University (EMU) but do not have a valid English proficiency certificate are required to take the English Proficiency Exam and meet the requirements of their departments. The exemption criteria and the equivalent English Preparatory School (EPS) success requirements stipulated by Foreign Languages and English Preparatory School (FLEPS) for students who have any valid language (English) proficiency certificate are as follows:

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

 For the departments who have the courses ENGL181-182 in their program, students who have successfully completed the English Preparatory Program at another university and students who are exempted from English Preparatory Program (the validity of the document is evaluated by the FLEPS Administration) in a different university are offered two choices:

a) Take ENGL181-182 courses

b) Take the EMU FLEPS English Proficiency Exam Stage II. If the student receives a score of minimum 60%, s/he is enrolled in ENGL191-192 courses. If not, the student will have to take ENGL181-182 courses.

 Students who have no valid documents regarding their language level are required to take the EMU FLEPS English Proficiency Exam Stage I. If successful, these students are required to sit the EMU FLEPS English Proficiency Exam Stage II.

 The minimum requirement is 50% for most departments, 60% for 3 departments and 70% for 3 faculties. Departments / Faculties with minimum 60% and 70% success conditions are as follows:

 Students whose departments require minimum 60% in the EMU FLEPS English Proficiency Test Stage II can enrol *in* ENGL191-192 courses if they score minimum 60%.

5. Since Foreign Languages Education Department (FLE) program does not entail ENGL181-182 and ENGL191-192 courses, these courses are not applicable to FLE students. They need to get minimum 60% in order to be exempted from English Preparatory Programs. Students who score 0-59% are subject to be interviewed at FLE Department and upon being successful, they are eligible to start their education in the FLE Department.

 Students who are not successful in English Proficiency Exam Stage II attend the English Preparatory School for a minimum of one semester or one year, depending on their English language level.




